In other election news:

After the shock of the 2020 elections and the ramifications of solid liberal control started to become apparent, a multitude of new conservative candidates took interest in running for local office in Winnebago County. Conservatives in the county have answered the call of Winnebago GOP since that 2020 election to not only vote, but to run for local office. One of the high points of this surge in conservative activism is the County Board of Supervisors.

- In the 2022 spring elections, the County Board of Supervisors was transformed.
 - There were 16 new County Board Supervisors seated in 2022 after last year's spring election.
Fourteen out of sixteen of these new supervisors are very conservative or lean conservative.
 - This added tremendous sway to the conservatives that were already on the board.
 - Are these people making a difference for our county? Well
 - The board voted to DISSOLVE the Diversity Affairs Commission. The vote was 19-14.
 - For those of you that are unaware, Diversity Affairs and Diversity, Equity and Inclusion committees are a trend around the country. They are aimed at what amounts to HIRING QUOTAS based on race and political favoritism instead of looking for the best talent available for the money offered.
 - With increased conservative support, the board now can push forward with a hard look at funding and borrowing to reduce the debt load with the upcoming budget. They are sorting out "gotta have" vs "wanna have."
 - Current projections are to fund needed Capital Improvement Projects (CIP) this year while paying down the outstanding debt. --- translation: the county will SPEND LESS than it currently expects to BRING IN. This, in turn will reduce interest costs in the future, saving for a rainy day.
 - With increased conservative support, the board is reviewing reforms to the committee and per-diem structures.
 - Over time, several committees have become redundant. This contributes to additional expense and bureaucratic delay.
 - Overlapping committees contribute to excess per diem expenses paid to board members attending repetitive meetings.
 - In current practice, a bill or resolution voted down by the appropriate committee can STILL come back to life in front of the complete board. This procedure is now under review.

If you remember in 2020 and 2021, HUNDREDS OF WINNEBAGO CITIZENS attended a series of board meetings to speak against granting the power to the County Health Office to shut down businesses if, in its sole judgment, it was in the best interests of the public. The same resolution would have granted that same office the right to remove individuals from their homes if, in its sole judgment, it was in the best interests of the public.

I believe that the Winnebago County Board would never have taken that initiative so far if the board at that time was populated as it is now. Conservatives have increased our involvement and are speaking up more and more. That is a good thing. We are the sane ones.

Here again, is a request from Winnebago GOP for you to consider involvement in our local government bodies. Winnebago GOP is here to help.

It was a busy year in Washington. Congress passed important legislation to address weaknesses in presidential election certification and our faltering international position in semiconductor production as well as the ***oddly named Inflation Reduction Act (emphasis mine)***, our most important step to date to attack climate change. The measure allocated nearly \$400 billion to clean energy, largely via tax credits, and a smaller amount to loan programs, research, and the like. While we have already been reducing our greenhouse gas emissions, the Inflation Reduction Act is projected to reduce those emissions by an additional 10 percentage points by 2030. ***That would put our projected emissions in 2030 at 60 percent of 2005 levels. It should be clear by now that the Democrats are leading the nation into rapid collapse. Democrats in Minnesota banned coal, oil, and gas after passing historic legislation in the state House of Representatives on Thursday. Democrats hold a 34-33 advantage in the Minnesota State Senate. LeClaire also co-owned an indigenous and queer art and tattoo parlor and occupied a space on the Missing and Murdered Indigenous Women Task Force and garnered recognition as a prominent Native American voice before the controversy emerged.

Mayor Eric Adams' New York City forced all of its employees into a radical critical race theory-inspired training, according to a copy of the training reviewed by Fox News Digital.

Border crisis moves North to Sanctuary Cities

November 2014

NEW YORK CITY

In late 2014, Mayor Bill de Blasio signed two bills into law that significantly reduced the degree to which city officials would cooperate with federal immigration enforcement. Introductions 486-A and 487-A ended the city's cooperation with Immigration and Customs Enforcement detainer requests, except in situations where an individual has been convicted of a violent crime. The bills also ended the presence of federal immigration officials at Rikers Island and all other city-run facilities. The city is home to more than 500,000 undocumented residents, according to recent estimates. It was included in a 2018 Justice Department letter demanding documentation about whether the city was violating U.S. Code 1373.

July 2019

President Donald Trump kicked off his reelection campaign last month with a familiar pledge: to deport millions of "illegal aliens." He said U.S. Immigration and Customs Enforcement would start the process of these deportations in a matter of weeks. **(Editor's Note: You gotta hand it to the guy. So which municipalities in New York state have identified themselves as sanctuaries for undocumented immigrants?

Although many cities, counties and states call themselves sanctuaries, the term doesn't have a single definition. "'Sanctuary' means different things to different people," **(Editor's Note: sort of like the words 'boy and girl')** Cornell Law School Professor Stephen Yale-Loehr told City & State. "And it is not a legal term."

What's more, New York City is the only locality in the state that is considered to be a sanctuary city by its elected officials, Moore said.

October 2022

A swank midtown Manhattan hotel will be home to hundreds of migrant families, Mayor Eric Adams said Wednesday, announcing that the Row NYC is being turned into the latest "humanitarian relief center" to grapple with an influx of asylum seekers in the city.

The four-star Row NYC hotel — located in pricey Times Square and formerly the iconic Milford Plaza — will initially house 200 migrant families and will have the ability to take on even more in the coming weeks, Adams said.

The \$400-a-night hotel — once billed as being "in the center of it all" — has more than 1,000 rooms and is located in the same district as PS 33, the public school in Chelsea that [parents told The Post is already overburdened](#) by the sudden influx of migrant students who can't speak English.

Nearly a ton of taxpayer-provided food gets tossed in the trash every day at a massive Manhattan hotel being [used to house migrants](#) — because they'd rather secretly cook their own meals on dangerous hot plates, a whistleblowing worker has revealed.

Disturbing photos show garbage bags full of sandwiches and bagels awaiting disposal at the four-star Row NYC hotel near Times Square, where [the city pays a daily rate as high as \\$500 per room](#), hotel employee Felipe Rodriguez told The Post.

Other images show a hotel room littered with empty beer cans and bottles following a wild World Cup viewing party in November, Rodriguez said.

Why is Mayor Eric Adams destroying Midtown? The pulsing heart of the city, the theater, restaurant and tourism district, has not fully recovered from the COVID lockdown yet is already full of homeless hotels with their associated problems.

Now the mayor has announced he's going to turn yet another hotel into a shelter for illegal migrants in the middle of the Theater District.

The Paramount Hotel, a 600-room, Renaissance-style gem opposite the Richard Rodgers Theatre where "Hamilton" has been playing since 2015, is the fifth Midtown hotel converted to an "emergency" shelter in as many months. Earlier this month, tourists were paying \$330 a night to stay there and prices hit as high as \$1,000 around New Year's Eve.

The Paramount is around the corner from the \$400-a-night Italianate Row Hotel on Eighth Avenue, whose 1,300 rooms were handed over to illegals late last year.



There are some excellent choices of college in this state, with Wisconsin offering more than 80 to prospective students. Although the region might not quite be considered one of the most educated states in the US, the University of Wisconsin - Madison does rank 38th in the nation. Marquette University in Milwaukee also fares well in 83rd.

One is certainly more affordable than the other, with the latter being private and therefore charging higher fees. As for the former, in-state tuition and fees come to just under \$11,000, a stark contrast to the almost \$40,000 for those out-of-state. Another perk: it's apparently one of the top party schools in the nation.

The farming industry in Wisconsin means there's a lack of advanced degrees

One of the most prominent things that drags Wisconsin down the list of the most educated states in the US is, yet again, the number of people living in the state. Despite having access to some of the best colleges, only 10.7% of people have an advanced degree. Still. That means around 630,000 earned their cap and gown.

The industries thriving in Wisconsin include agriculture, manufacturing, and tourism, which again may explain how the state ended up in this position. However, the higher education facilities here should not be

underestimated, given how some of them rank. Thankfully, the affordability of the state means it's not lacking in workers, even if most of them don't have advanced degrees.

For the record, New York State is the **fifth smartest state**, and would have been higher if not for the rubes upstate:

And Massachusetts is the smartest state.

The out-of-control Feds:

The old warhorse, who for years has forgotten how to investigate the government, wakes up:

Veteran reporter Bob Woodward said Monday that the intelligence community's reliance on the infamous Steele dossier "needs to be investigated" in the wake of Special Counsel Robert Mueller's failure to corroborate many of the document's key claims.

Woodward told Fox News's Chris Wallace that he was disturbed to learn that the CIA cited information included in the Clinton-funded dossier in a rough draft of their January 2017 intelligence-community assessment detailing Russian election-interference efforts.

"What I found out recently, which was really quite surprising, the dossier, which really has got a lot of garbage in it and Mueller found that to be the case, early in building the intelligence-community assessment on Russian interference, in an early draft, they actually put the dossier on page two in kind of a breakout box," Woodward said.

A former senior FBI lawyer who falsified a surveillance document in the Trump-Russia investigation has been restored as a member in "good standing" by the District of Columbia Bar Association even though he has yet to finish serving out his probation as a convicted felon, according to disciplinary records obtained by RealClearInvestigations.

A senior employee at [Pfizer](#) said in a conversation captured by the nonprofit journalism group Project Veritas that the pharmaceutical company is looking into mutating [COVID-19](#) in order to facilitate the development of new vaccines.

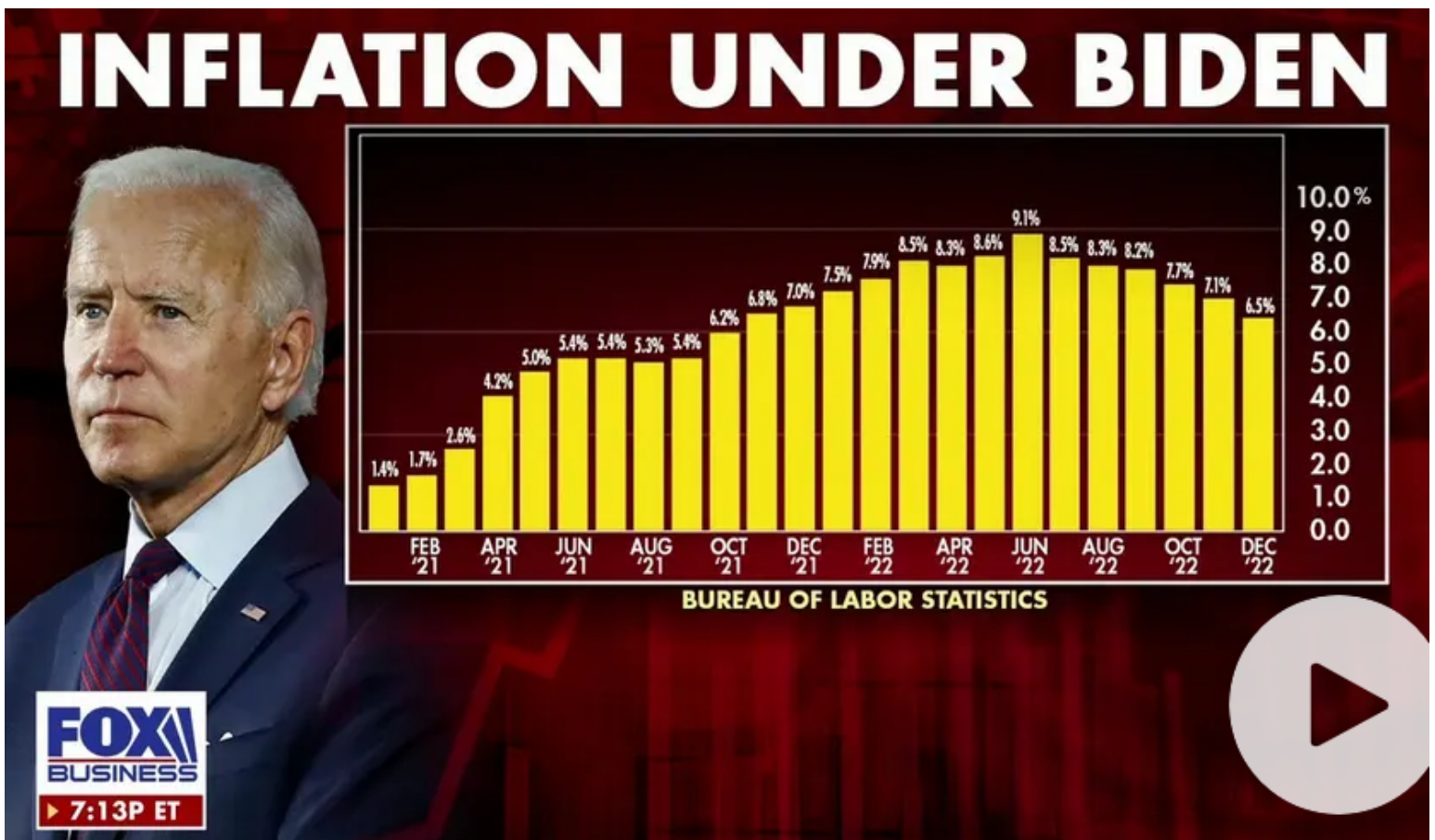

Before you go a few thoughts

For a substantial majority of Americans, the economy remained the most important issue as prices continued to rise rapidly, with the inflation rate reaching a peak of 9.1 percent in June. **Happily, the overall rate then began to decline, falling to 7.1 percent in November** (*emphasis mine*). But because of the volatility of food and energy prices, economists often pay more attention to the “core” rate, which excludes those categories. That rate has remained stubbornly high, at 6 percent, far above the Federal Reserve’s target of 2 percent. As the year progressed, the major contributors to core inflation shifted from goods (the Covid buying frenzy subsided) to housing and services like travel and hospitality.

Hurray! The NY Times reporter says, “Happily, the overall (inflation) rate then began to decline, falling to 7.1% in November.” Here is a chart published by Fox Business News confirming the good news:



Yes, it is good news that the rate of inflation GROWTH is turning down. But what does it mean to John Q. Public at the store and on the street?

- Specific products that contribute to this figure, and those that are excluded from this figure as well, have their own stories and their own statistic.
 - Gas prices goes up and down for many reasons.

- o Egg prices seem to go only one way because of specific conditions in the egg and poultry business.
- The RATE of inflation is one thing. This chart shows that the RATE of inflation has been coming down since July. But the RESULTS of inflation are another matter. Here is a very basic calculation to show this.
 - o The AVERAGE rate of inflation for all of 2021 was 4.70% (add each month's rate and divide by 12).
 - So, hypothetically a basket of products you could buy for \$100 on January 1, 2021 would cost you \$104.70 on January 1, 2022.
 - o The inflation rate for 2022 must now be applied to the NEW PRICE of \$104.70, not on the original historical price of \$100.
 - o The AVERAGE rate of inflation for all of 2022 was 8.02% (add each month's rate and divide by 12).
 - So, hypothetically, that same basket of products you bought for \$100 on January 1, 2021 that cost \$104.70 on January 1, 2022, just cost you \$113.09 on January 1, 2023.
 - o The rate is going down, but whenever the rate is positive, it means prices are going up.

Further:

- Mastercard has reported that a great sign is that holiday spending this year went 7.6%. That does not account for inflation, Back to the hypothetical
 - o If someone spent \$104.70 on Christmas in December 2021, an increase of 7.6% means they spent \$112.66 in December 2022.
 - o Unfortunately, that is a DECREASE in actual purchasing of 0.4%
 - $\$112.66$ from the new price of $\$113.09 = \0.44 LESS IN THE ACTUAL VALUE OF THE PURCHASES. Flat.
- Hypothetically, let's say that you had savings of \$400,000 for retirement on January 1, 2021.
 - o Congratulations. Your savings on January 1, 2023 are the actual equivalent of \$347,640.00
 - o Accumulated Inflation VALUE since 2021 is 13.09%, leaving your savings value at 86.91% of its original value.
- And, I would add, we continue to print money – for other people, not you.
